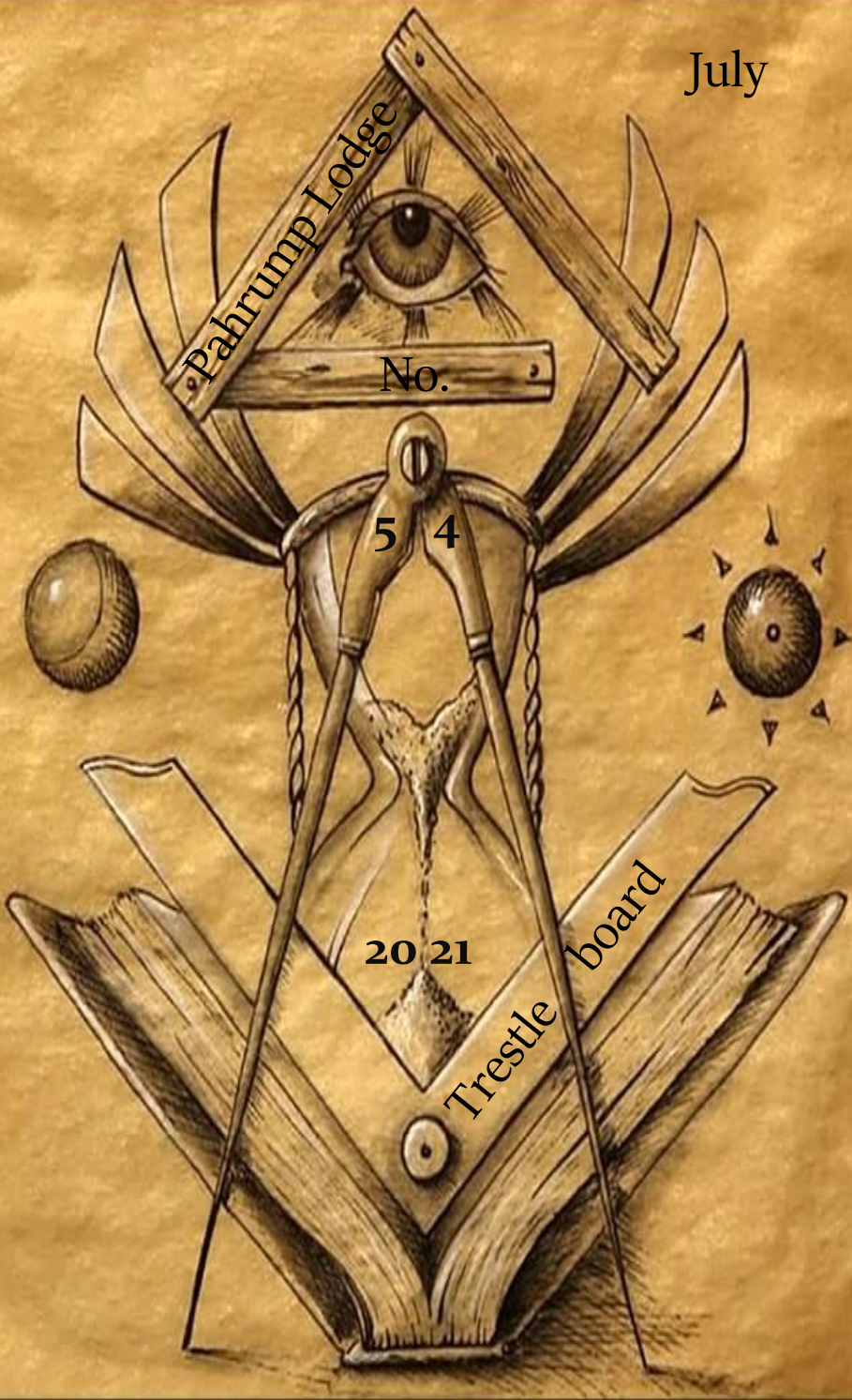

Famous Names

Kit Carson,

A renowned Indian scout was a member of Montezuma Lodge No. 109, Santa Fe, New Mexico.

William Cody,

Was a member of Platte Valley Lodge No. 32, North Platte, Nebraska. He is best known as Buffalo Bill.

Edward VII,

King of England and Grand Master of Masons in England from 1874 to 1901. He was initiated a Mason by the King of Sweden on November 9th, 1869, when King Edward was twenty-eight and Prince of Wales.

Major General James H. Doolittle,

Made a master Mason on August 16th, 1918, in Hollenbock Lodge No. 319, Los Angeles, California.

Henry Ford,

Received the honorary 33^o of the Northern Jurisdiction of the Supreme Council of the Scottish Rite on December 6th, 1940. He was made a Master Mason in Palestine Lodge No. 357, Detroit, Michigan.

Harry Houdini,

The great magician, was made a Mason in St. Cecile Lodge No 568, New York City, on August 21st, 1923.

General Douglas Mac Arthur,

Was born on January 26th, 1880, in Little Rock, Arkansas and was made a Mason "at sight" on January 17th, 1936, by the Grand Master of the Philippine Islands. He affiliated with Manila Lodge No. 1, Manila, P.I. He became a 32^o Mason on March 28, 1936, also in Manila and on December 8th, 1947, was given the 33^o.

John Philip Sousa,

Was a member of Hiram Lodge No. 10, Washington D.C. This famous bandmaster's most noted work is "Stars and Stripes Forever." His father's name was Samuel Ochs. John Philip got the name of "Sousa" from the first letters of the following: Samuel Ochs United States America. He was born in Washington, D.C. on November 6th, 1854, and died at Reading Pennsylvania, March 6th, 1932.

- 1. Who was the first recorded Mason to become a permanent resident of America?**
 - A. John Skene, whose name is 27th on the roll of members of Aberdeen Lodge No. 1, Scotland. He came to America in October 1682 and settled in Burlington, New Jersey. He became Deputy Governor of New Hersey and died while in office in 1690
- 2. Who was the first native born American to become a Freemason?**
 - A. Jonathan Belcher, Governor of Massachusetts, and New Jersey, who was made a Mason in 1704 while on a visit to England.
