#### William Jennings Bryan

Secretary of State under Woodrow Wilson, was a member of Lincoln Lodge No. 19, Lincoln, Nebraska.

#### **Robert Burns**

Made a Master Mason on October 1, 1781, St. James' Lodge, Tarbolton, Scotland.

#### Aaron Burr,

Third Vice President of the United States (1801–04) was made a Master Mason on September 13, 1806 in Union Lodge No. 40, Danbury, Connecticut.

#### **Ionathan Swift**

Author of Gulliver's Travels, was a Mason.

### Admiral Robert E. Peary

Was made a Mason in 1896 in Kane Lodge No. 454, New York City. He is remembered particularly for his discovery of the North Pole.
