




Franklin reprinted Anderson's Constitutions in 1734. This is commonly known as the "Franklin Reprint." Seventeen copies of the original edition are in existence. It is the rarest American Masonic book.

Aaron Burr,


Third Vice President of the United States (1801-04) was made a Master Mason on September 13, 1806 in Union Lodge No. 40, Danbury, Connecticut.

A. There have been many such instances by the permission of some Grand Master. However, there is one instance which probably will never be duplicated: The Fourth Duke of Atholl (about nine months before he attained his majority) was initiated, passed, and raised, and then installed as Master, and then elected Grand Master- all on the same day, March 1, 1775,

2. What Grand Master in America held the office the longest?

A. Thomas J. Shryock of Maryland, who held the office for nearly thirty-three years. He died in office..
