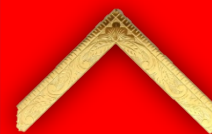

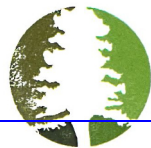

New Six Step Method of joining our lodge:

The following is some of the information that we will be using on bringing in new candidates.

On behalf of the Pahrump Masonic Lodge #54, thank you for your interest in Masonry. Becoming a Mason is a serious and, potentially, life changing decision. It is not one you should take lightly and will require substantial commitment on your part. However, the rewards of being a Mason can be significant. This is not measured in material wealth, for the Lodge doesn't offer business opportunities or other material gain, but a system of continual improvement, community involvement, self-discovery and camaraderie with like-minded men.

Historically, men became Freemasons through family or close friends who belonged to the Lodge. This connection ensured that members of good standing in the Lodge knew the character and background of the potential candidate for membership. However, today most men approach Masonry through casual connections (Internet, calling the Lodge, etc.) after their interest has been kindled by reading books and/or seeing videos about the Lodge. Because of this, the Pahrump Masonic Lodge #54 has developed this plan of six steps that will allow the candidate to know if the Lodge is right for them and the Lodge to know if they are a good candidate to potentially be raised to the highest degree in Craft Masonry: Master Mason.

The six steps are:

Step one - Brief interview/discussion

Step two - In-depth interview/Discussion

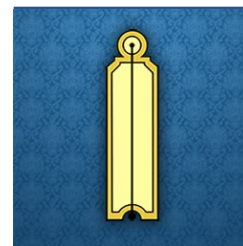
Step three - The follow up meeting

Step four - The social meeting

Step five - ongoing social events

Step six - Asking for a petition

The idea of this is to let them get to know us and let us to get to know them. In the past, we have had candidates up for vote that most of the lodge has never even met before.

1. The American flag was sewn by Betsy Ross, whose husband was a member of St. John's Lodge, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Frederic Bartholdi, a Mason, designed it. The Grand Lodge of New York laid the cornerstone of its base with Masonic Ritual.

2. The highest Masonic Lodge in the United States is Corinthian Lodge No.35 located in Leadville, Colorado. Its elevation is 10,152 feet.

The Lowest Lodge in the United States is Winnedumah Lodge No. 287 of Bishop, CA. It occasionally hold meetings in Death Valley at 270 feet below sea level.
