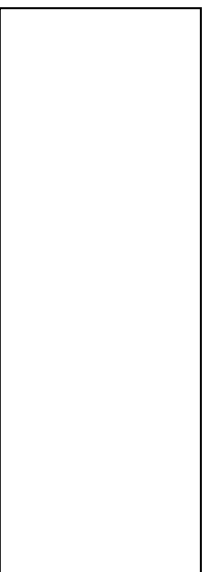

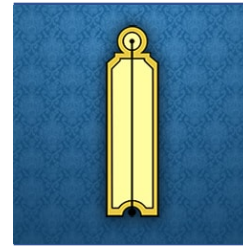
I AM FREEMASON.

1. In 1892 the world's tallest building was the Masonic Temple at Randolph and State Streets in Chicago.
2. Dr. Edward Jenner, in 1789 discovered the vaccination process against smallpox. At the time, he was the Worshipful Master of the Faith and Friendship Lodge #270 in Berkeley, England.
3. In 1952, eighty-nine percent of the U.S. Supreme Court Justices were Freemasons.
4. Brother and General Thomas H. Benton, Grand Master in Iowa, 1860-1862, posted federal troops around Brother Albert Pike's Masonic Library at Little Rock, Arkansas to protect its valuable contents when that city was invaded during the Civil War.
