Fun Masonic Facts

- **1.** Masonic symbols are usually regarded as existing because of the fraternity's secrecy. However, in reality, Freemasonry started being illustrated by symbols because at the very beginning most Freemasons could not read, so the symbols served to remind members of the fraternity's teachings.
- **2.** At the time it was built in 1892 the Masonic Temple in Chicago, Illinois, was the world's tallest building. It was twenty-two stories high.
- **3.**During the American civil war enemy soldiers who recognized each other as Freemasons helped each other and saved each other's lives. Even during war these Freemasons' loyalty to the craft did not fade.
- **4.** In 1860 in Limerick, Ireland, there as found a stone in a small chapel, dated 1517, with the following inscription: "I will serve to live with love & care, upon the level, and by the square."
