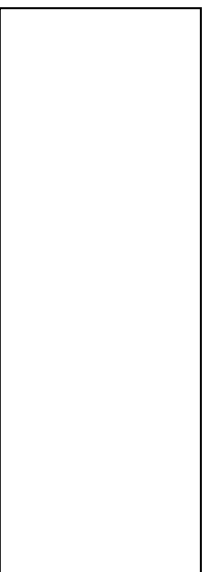

I therefore make a motion that Article III. Of Meetings of the Lodge be amended to read:

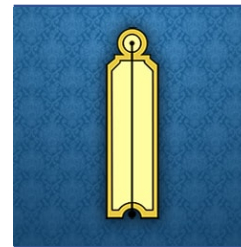
Article III. Of Meetings of the Lodge:
