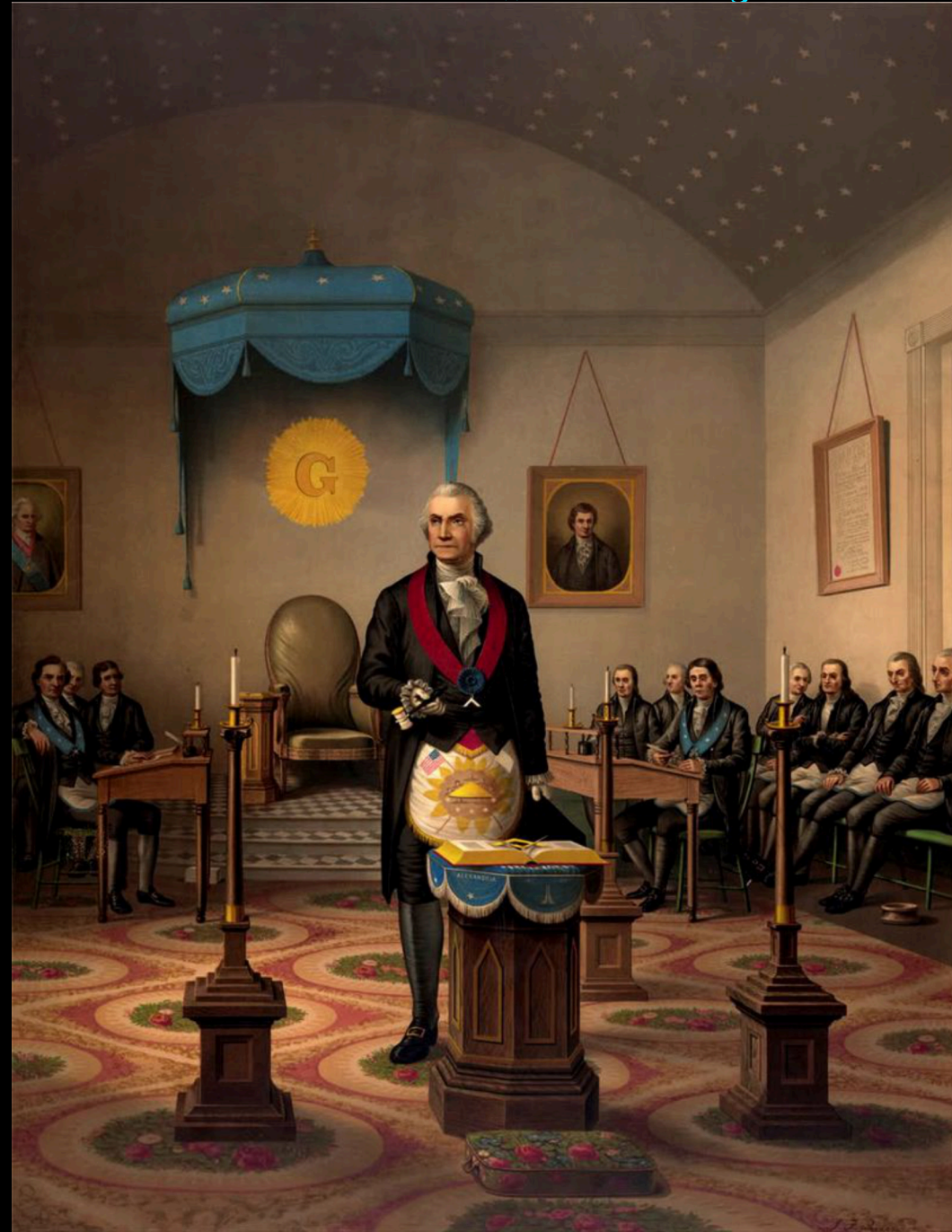

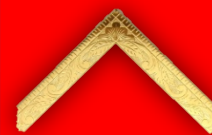

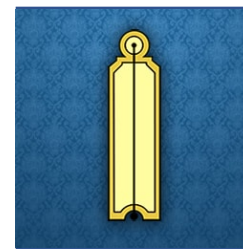

George Washington

George Washington was raised to the Sublime Degree of Master Mason in the Masonic lodge at Fredericksburg, Virginia. The lodge at Fredericksburg was organized in 1752 and comprised mostly of Scottish immigrants and merchants. The lodge's first secretary, Daniel Campbell, would later secure its charter from the Grand Lodge of Scotland in July 1758. After the formation of the Grand Lodge Virginia, the Lodge at Fredericksburg was re-chartered as Fredericksburg Lodge № 4 on January 30, 1787. The lodge continues to meet in its lodge hall, which is over 200 years old.

Prior to receiving the Third Degree, Washington was initiated as an Entered Apprentice Mason on November 4, 1752, and passed to the degree of Fellow Craft on March 3, 1753. The lodge's minute books record Washington attending next meeting of the lodge on September 1, 1753.
