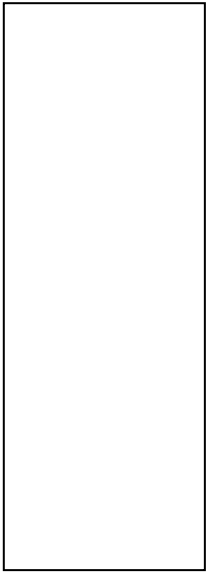

Cares about another's needs

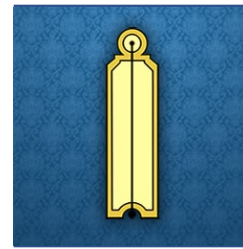
Don't let pressures of the moment
